Dear Sir,

In reply to your letter of 6th July, 1982, I regret that you have been put to the trouble of writing it, as the Black Russians come off the Provisional Register on the 1st July, 1982, and will be eligible for Championship status as from that date.

This was decided at the meeting that adopted the new breeds and colour listings, for the reasons as stated in your letter, that they had been on the Provisional Register long enough.

You will note in the new list that was circulated that the Black Russians have been listed, whereas other colours in other breeds formerly on Provisional register have not been listed. These now come under the New Colour (N.C.) class. This means that all colours in the various breeds that are stated on the list are eligible for Championship status. If it is not specifically stated, then it comes under the N.C. class.

We apologise for any inconvenience we may have caused.
